

Graphic Design Intern

The Darfur/Sudan Peace Network (DSPN) is a not-for-profit national coalition of organizations advocating for the Canadian government to play a greater role in ending the crisis in Darfur, Sudan.

Our operating model distributes responsibility and leadership among a dynamic and always evolving team. The success of the DSPN depends in large part on the hard work and enthusiasm of interns and coordinators who are often un-paid. New interns will have the opportunity to take on increasingly greater leadership and responsibility within the organization.

The work of the Graphic Design intern will be essential in updating various sections of the DSPN website and in designing a new section on Darfuri and Sudanese perspectives.

The main responsibilities of this intern position will depend on the design skills of the interested candidate.

Application deadline: Position will be removed from the website as soon as it is filled

Start and end dates: Begins immediately; position length depends on the level of involvement chosen by the candidate

Hourly commitment: A minimum of 3 hours per week; the ideal candidate would be able to devote considerably more time than this

Location: The DSPN office in Montréal

Remuneration: Volunteer position (Please note this position can be treated as an internship for school credit if approved by the institution attended.)

You can either provide a link to a sample of your work online or include a screenshot in the application package. You can expect to receive a response within two weeks of submitting your application package.
