

Video Editing Intern

The Darfur/Sudan Peace Network (DSPN) is a not-for-profit national coalition of organizations advocating for the Canadian government to play a greater role in ending the crisis in Darfur, Sudan.

Our operating model distributes responsibility and leadership among a dynamic and always evolving team. The success of the DSPN depends in large part on the hard work and enthusiasm of interns and coordinators who are often un-paid. New interns will have the opportunity to take on increasingly greater leadership and responsibility within the organization.

The DSPN has collected a number of video clips related to Darfur. The Video Editing intern will be in charge of basic editing of this material for display on the DSPN website and YouTube. Technical support for putting the edited clips online can be found if needed.

The main responsibilities of this intern position will depend on the video editing skills of the interested candidate.

Application deadline: Position will be removed from the website as soon as it is filled

Start and end dates: Begins immediately; position length depends on the level of involvement chosen by the candidate

Hourly commitment: Depends on project

Location: Preferably at the DSPN office in Montréal

Remuneration: Volunteer position (Please note this position can be treated as an internship for school credit if approved by the institution attended.)

Please e-mail an application package consisting of cover letter, resume with two or more references, and sample of video editing work to interns@sudan.peacenetWORK.ca, and we will assess your skills and arrange an interview. You can either provide a link to a sample of your work online or arrange to drop off a CD/DVD of your work at the DSPN office. You can expect to receive a response within two weeks of submitting your application package.

If you are not available to volunteer at this time but are interested in joining the DSPN team at a later date, please feel free to submit an application package which we will look over and keep on file.
